\*The "Indirect Connection Charge" applies where the new customer has immediate access (by previously paying the cost of the main) to the Township Water System.

\*\*The "Direct Connection Charge" applies where the new customer had not previously paid for any cost of connection to the Township Water System.

4.00 inch	2,000 cubic feet	\$193.16
6.00 inch	4,000 cubic feet	\$316.58

\*Should more water be consumed by any premises in a quarter beyond that which is allowed (as specified above), then an additional water commodity charge of **\$1.61 per 100 cubic feet** shall be due.
