

**CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF WHITE LAKE  
AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 24, MESSAGE ORDINANCE OF THE  
WHITE LAKE TOWNSHIP CODE OF ORDINANCES**

Notice is hereby given that at a regular board meeting on December 18, 2018 the Charter Township of White Lake introduced amendments to Chapter 24, Section 24-5, paragraph a15, of the Charter Township of White Lake Code of Ordinances. Final consideration to be made at the January 15, 2018 regular board meeting.

**THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF WHITE LAKE ORDAINS:**

**ARTICLE 1. AMENDMENT**

Chapter 24, Section 24-5, paragraph (a 15) of the Township of White Lake Code of Ordinances, referred to as the Massage Ordinance is deleted and amended as follows:

One passport size photograph must be provided by applicant for the permit.

**ARTICLE 2: SEVERABILITY.**

If any section, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared to be unconstitutional, void, illegal or ineffective by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such selection, clause or provision declared to be unconstitutional, void or illegal shall thereby cease to be a part of this Ordinance, but the remainder of the Ordinance shall stand and be in full force and effect.

**ARTICLE 3: EFFECTIVE DATE.**

This Ordinance shall take effect following publication in the manner prescribed by law.

**ARTICLE 4: REPEALER.**

All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent necessary to give this ordinance full force and effect.

**ARTICLE 5: ADOPTION.**

This Ordinance is hereby declared to have been adopted by the Township Board of this Charter Township of White Lake at a meeting thereof duly called and held on the \_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2019, and ordered to be given publication in the manner prescribed by the Charter of the Charter Township of White Lake.
