Village Acres Iron Removal Plant

Start of construction for the new Village Acres Iron Filtration Plant will begin February 15, 2016 and will provide iron free, potable water to nearly 80% of the White Lake Township water customers. The facility will consist of a new 40 foot by 60 foot building, housing two (2) 8 foot diameter by 17 foot long pressure filters, piping, valves, electrical upgrades, SCADA system, backup generator and chemical feed systems. The proposed facility will have a maximum capacity of 2000 gallon per minute and will be located at the existing Village Acres site. Construction is expected to take approximately 12 months to complete.
